Emergency Management is a continuous cycle based around the four main principles of Preparedness, Response, Recovery, and Mitigation. (City of Sacramento, Office of Emergency Management)

# Mitigation

This phase includes any activities that prevent an emergency, reduce the likelihood of occurrence, or reduce the damaging effects of unavoidable hazards. Mitigation activities should be considered long before an emergency. (FEMA Training, is10\_unit3)

# Preparedness

This phase includes developing plans for what to do, where to go, or who to call for help before an event occurs; actions that will improve your chances of successfully dealing with an emergency. (FEMA Training, is10\_unit3)

# Response

Your safety and well-being in an emergency depend on how prepared you are and on how you respond to a crisis. By being able to act responsibly and safely...Includes actions taken to save lives and prevent further property damage in an emergency situation. Response is putting your preparedness plans into action.  
(FEMA Training, is10\_unit3)

# Recovery

After an emergency and once the immediate danger is over, your continued safety and well-being will depend on your ability to cope with rearranging your life and environment...Includes actions taken to return to a normal or an even safer situation following an emergency. (FEMA Training, is10\_unit3)
