Application Process:

1. Fill out the online application- follow the link here: jvs.org/trades-internship
2. Eligible applicants with complete applications will be invited to a phone interview
3. Selected qualified applicants will be invited to an in-person or virtual interview
4. Selected candidates will be required to attend an onboarding orientation
